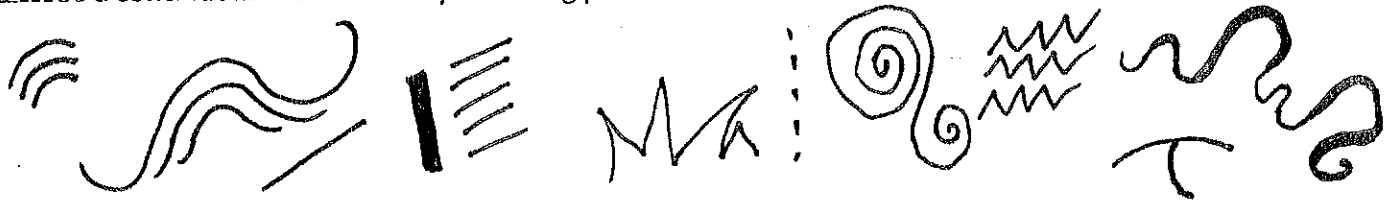
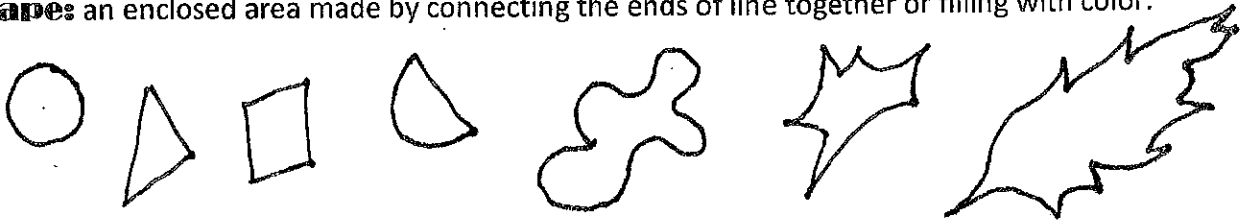


**Elements of Art:** what you NEED to create a work of art.

**Line:** a continuous mark made by a moving point.



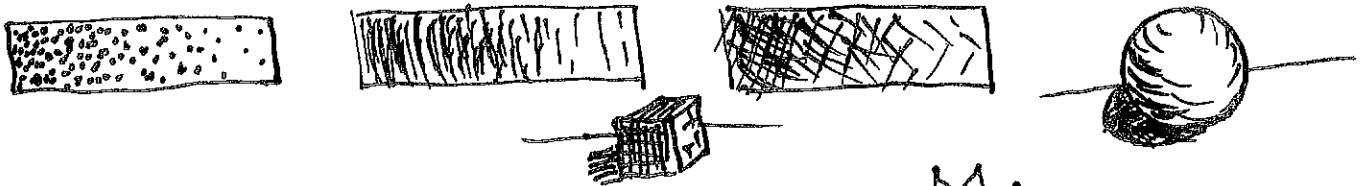
**Shape:** an enclosed area made by connecting the ends of line together or filling with color.



**Form:** representing 3D like sculptures or including highlights and shadows in a 2D drawing.



**Value:** the lightness and darkness of a color.



**Texture:** the way a surface feels or looks like it would feel.



**Color:** represents the 12 colors on the color wheel: r, ro, o, yo, y, yg, g, bg, b, bv, v, rv.

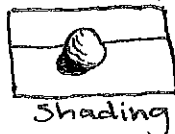
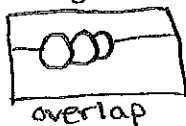
Hue=color, Intensity= how bright and vivid the color is, Value= how light or dark the color is.



**Space:** the distance around objects. Representing depth in a drawing by layering objects or making objects appear close or far away from you.

Foreground= objects closest to you Middleground: objects in the middle area of the artwork.

Background: Objects far away from you.
