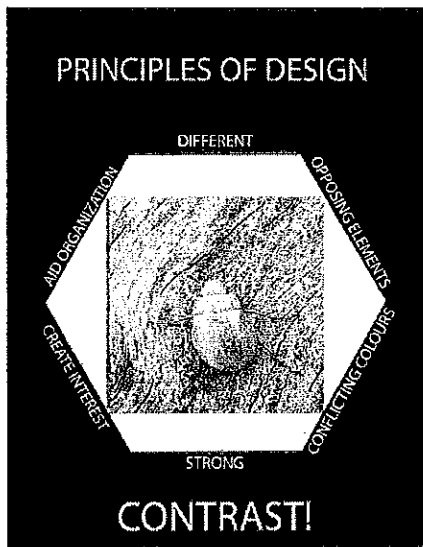
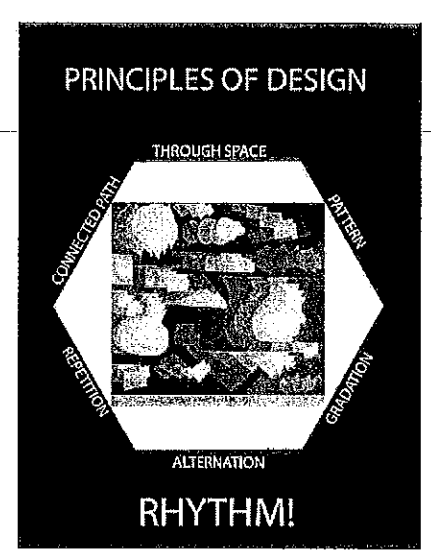
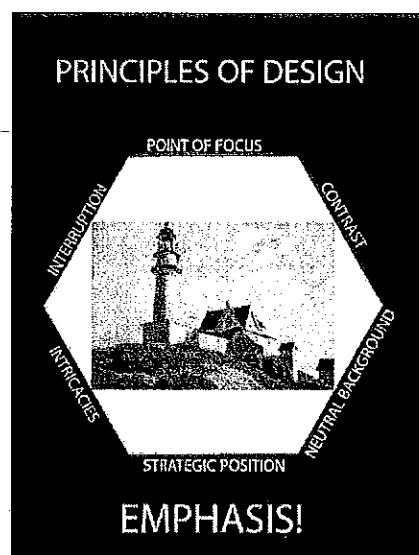
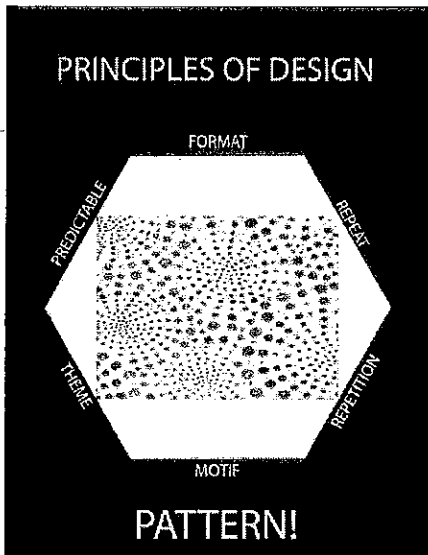
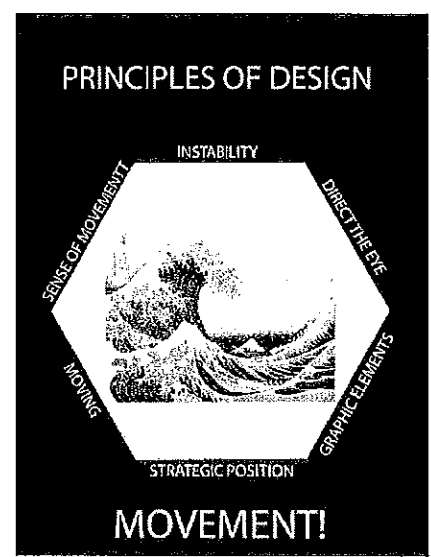
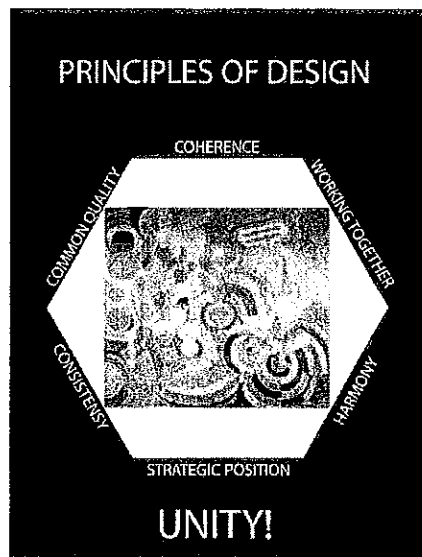
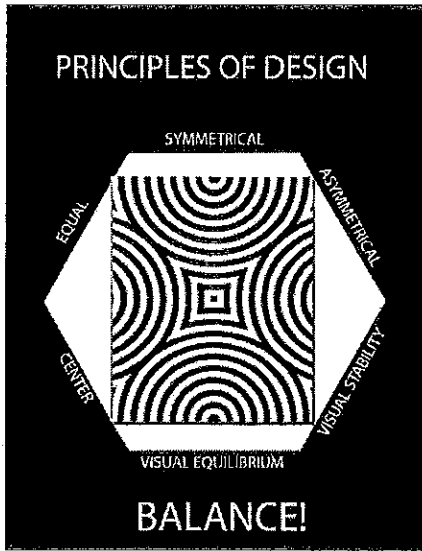


Principles: What you SEE within the design of the artwork.



Balance- a sense of stability in the body of work by filling the space equally.

Unity- repeating similar elements to show a thought out plan. Keeping the artwork simple.

Movement- when your eye follows the lines/edges through the artwork.

Pattern- decorates the surface with planned repeated units of design.

Emphasis- a focal point in the artwork that stands out.

Rhythm- the visual beat in the artwork.

Contrast- refers to using opposites because of the strong differences in the element. Big/small, light/dark, rough/smooth
